- A. Ordinance No. 01-2018 public hearing/possible adoption
 - 1. The Mayor to read the said Ordinance by Title, advising of its publication in its entirety in The Coast Star on January 11, 2018:

ORDINANCE NO. 01-2018

CALENDAR YEAR 2018 ORDINANCE TO EXCEED THE MUNICIPAL BUDGET APPROPRIATION LIMITS AND TO ESTABLISH A CAP BANK (N.J.S.A. 40A:4-45.14) IN THE BOROUGH OF SEA GIRT, MONMOUTH COUNTY, NEW JERSEY

- WHEREAS, the Local Government Cap Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:4-45.1 et seq., provides that in the preparation of its annual budget, a municipality shall limit any increase in said budget up to 2.5% unless authorized by ordinance to increase it to 3.5% over the previous year's final appropriations, subject to certain exceptions; and,
- WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:4:45-15a provides that a municipality may, when authorized by ordinance, appropriation the difference between the amount of its actual final appropriation and the 3.5% percentage rate as an exception to its final appropriations in either of the next two succeeding years; and,
- WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of Sea Girt in the County of Monmouth finds it advisable and necessary to increase its CY 2018 budget by up to 3.5% over the previous year's final appropriations in the interest of promoting the health, safety and welfare of the citizens; and,
- WHEREAS, the Borough Council hereby determines that a 3.5% increase in the budget for said year, amounting to \$179,700.00 in excess of the increase in final appropriations otherwise permitted by the local Government Cap Law is advisable and necessary; and,
- WHEREAS, the Borough Council hereby determines that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Sea Girt, in the County of Monmouth, a majority of the full authorized membership of this governing body affirmatively concurring, that in the CY 2018 budget year, the final appropriations of the Borough of Sea Girt shall, in accordance with this Ordinance and N.J.S.A. 40A:4-45.14, be increased by 3.5%, amounting to \$179,700.00 and that the CY 2018 municipal budget for Borough of Sea Girt be approved and adopted in accordance with this Ordinance.
- **BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final year budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years.
- **BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that a certified copy of this Ordinance as introduced be filed with the Director of the Division of Local Government Services within five (5) days of introduction.
- **BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that a certified copy of the Ordinance upon adoption, with the recorded vote included thereon, be filed with said Director within five (5) days after such adopted.

1. Ordinance No. 02-2018: The Mayor to read the said Ordinance by Title:

ORDINANCE NO. 02-2018

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AND SUPPLEMENT CHAPTER XVII, ZONING, SECTION 17-2, "DEFINITIONS" AND SECTION 17-7, "CERTIFICATES AND PERMITS" OF THE LAND USE VOLUME OF THE BOROUGH OF SEA GIRT CODE, IN THE BOROUGH OF SEA GIRT, COUNTY OF MONMOUTH

WHEREAS, the Borough of Sea Girt, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey (the "Borough") after public hearing and consideration of the recommendations of the Borough's Land Use Review Committee, desires to amend its Land Use Code to update Paragraph 17-7.1, Zoning Permit Application fees.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Sea Girt, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey (the "Borough"), as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter XVII of the Borough Code of the Borough of Sea Girt, entitled "Zoning" more particularly Paragraph 17-7.1 entitled "Zoning Permits", is hereby amended as follows:

a. Schedule of Application Fees for review of initial plan submission and one subsequent plan review, if necessary:

1.	New structures or additions exceeding 750 square feet in area	\$.75 per square foot, maximum fee of \$3,000
2.	 Engineering Review Escrow for new structures or additions from 750 sq. ft. through 2,499 sq. ft., inclusive (unexpended balance of escrow to be refunded) Engineering Review Escrow for new structures or additions 2,500 sq. ft. or greater (unexpended balance of 	\$1,500
	escrow to be refunded)	\$3,000
3.	Pools	\$1,000
4.	Engineering Review Fee for pools, escrow, unexpended	
	balance refunded to property owner	\$1,500
5.	Additions and renovations under 750 square feet (including	•
	garages and additional accessory structures)	\$750

- 6. Incidental structures (includes sheds, driveways, sidewalks, walkways, patios, hardscape, trellis, arbors, colonnades, fences, and line walls and similar structures, as determined by Zoning Official) \$250
- 7. Plan review, three or more submissions, not to exceed the cost \$500 each of the original permit

(Ord. #579, A VII, §1; Ord. #755, §13; Ord. #02-2006, §1)

- **SECTION 2.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
- **SECTION 3.** If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.
- **SECTION 4.** This Ordinance shall take effect upon publication in an official newspaper of the Borough, as required by and in conformance with law.
- **SECTION 5.** A copy of this Ordinance shall be filed with the Borough of Sea Girt Planning Board, the Monmouth County Planning Board and adjacent communities pursuant to *N.J.S.A.* 40:55D-16.

Council President Fetzer stated that the fees for multiple plan reviews for incidental structures were too high and noted that they should be capped at a maximum equivalent to the cost of the initial cost.

Councilwoman Anthony reported on the recent Board of Education Reorganization Meeting: Todd Leonhard and Hilary DeFeo were sworn in as members; Colleen Prior was re-elected as President.

Council President Fetzer reported as follows:

- Water Committee meeting will be held early February to discuss the plant's status and update our progress on the Asset Management Plan.

Mayor Farrell reported as follows:

- Noted he is still waiting for update from the County on Eighth Ave and Washington Blvd. repaving;
- SMRSA an 8 kW generator has been added to the facilities; Executive Director Mike Ruppel will be retiring in a few days; he noted that although Mr. Ruppel was eligible to retire in 2012, he stayed in his position to oversee post-Superstorm Sandy repairs; Ryan Krause will be taking over as the new Executive Director this month;

The Council adjourned for approximately 15 minutes while awaiting the arrival of Borough Engineer Peter Avakian. The meeting, with all members present, reconvened at approximately 8:10 PM.

10. **PRESENTATION** – Mayor Farrell introduced Borough Engineer Peter Avakian to present the Borough's plans for the Project known as the Rehabilitation of Carriage Way. The Mayor further commented that the proposed plan takes the needs of the residents and pedestrians into consideration.

Mr. Avakian noted that he has appeared before the Council at multiple public meetings at which the rehabilitation of Carriage Way and The Terrace were addressed. He began his comments with a PowerPoint presentation that provides detailed information regarding the proposed improvements to the road. At the conclusion of the presentation, the meeting was opened to the public for comments.

The following persons spoke in opposition to the proposed plan:

The following persons spoke in favor of the proposed plan:

Walter Robinson, Ocean Avenue John Shibles, Ocean Avenue

There was further extended discussion on the matter:

- Philip Vasan noted that he is in favor of enhancing the safety of the road by altering the configuration;
- Vinnie Dicks, Baltimore Blvd. noted that the Morris Family Collection (of photos) housed at the Library Company of Philadelphia shows that the historical use of the easterly road was a driveway;
- whether a curve in the road would serve to reduce the speed of traffic on the road;
- Councilpersons Foley and Meixsell commented on recent comments by Mr. Plum and other residents in a letter to *The Coast Star* alleging that the Council was "giving away" Borough property notwithstanding the provision in the Municipal Code that allows for driveways to cross Borough property to access Carriage Way; a right of way that exist for all property owners adjacent to Carriage Way.

• Councilperson Anthony asked the public to offer their suggestion for improving the roadway; there was no response from the public present.

11. PUBLIC PARTICIPATION ON ANY SUBJECT

Ron Gasiorowski, an attorney representing Ira Walker, questioned Mayor Farrell and Mr. Avakian regarding certain aspects of the proposed Carriage Way plan.

Sharon Kregg, Brooklyn Blvd., noted that the letter recently published in the paper is not fair to the Council for all they do for the town.

Jessica Farrell, Ocean Ave., thanked the Council for their efforts and noted that this Council has the best interests of all its residents at heart.

There being no further business, and **UPON MOTION** of Councilwoman Morris, seconded by Council President Fetzer, carried, that the meeting be finally and immediately adjourned at 10:05 PM.




Road Condition In 201













Existing Road Condition Toda








Proposed Road Surface





SECTION ROADWAY CROSS STONE TYPICAL


Underground Recharge Basin

- Borings were completed to determine the permeability of the soil in order to design and size the recharge system.






EXISTING Drive Way Access to Carrage Way




Southern Driveway

Average driveway distance from proposed roadway 32 feet Average driveway distance from existing roadway 14 feet




