C. Resolution No. 190-2019: Eighth Avenue Water Main Improvements
Approve Change Order and Supplemental Agreement No. 1 (net increase of \$26,339.); authorize Payment #2, M.S.P. Construction Corp., \$185,077.90

UPON MOTION of Councilman Mastrorilli, seconded by Council President Fetzer, carried, that the following Resolution be and the same is hereby adopted:

WHEREAS, the Borough of Sea Girt awarded a contract in the amount of \$410,717.00 to M.S.P. Construction Corp., Branchburg, NJ for the Project known as Improvements to Eighth Avenue Water Main on November 14, 2018; and,

WHEREAS, field changes to certain specified material and a reduction in the hours of the uniform traffic directors has resulted in a reduction to the contract of \$18,770.30; and,

WHEREAS, field changes required the installation of additional valves and an increase in the quantity of interpipe connections resulting in an increase to the contract of \$45,109.30; and,

WHEREAS, this statute also provides (a) if the municipal committee fails to submit the names of the nominees within the time prescribed, the governing body may, within the next fifteen (15) days, fill the vacancy by the appointment of a successor from the same political party which nominated the incumbent whose office has become vacant; and (b) if the governing body fails to appoint one of the nominees within the time prescribed, the municipal committee shall, within the next fifteen (15) days, appoint one of the nominees as the successor; and,

WHEREAS, on October 11, 2019 the Sea Girt Municipal Republican Committee presented the names of Matthew Begley, Joseph Griffin and Alan Zakin to fill the vacancy.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Sea Girt, in the County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey as follows:

- 1. Matthew Begley is hereby appointed to the Borough Council position vacated by Anne B. Morris in accordance with the provisions *N.J.S.A.* 40A:16-1 et seq., the New Jersey Municipal Vacancy Law, for the term which will expire December 31, 2020.
- 2. This resolution has been adopted by a majority vote of the remaining members of the governing body.
- 3. The Borough Clerk is directed to forward a certified copy of this Resolution to Matthew Begley and the Sea Girt Municipal Republican Committee.
