WHEREAS, the Borough of Sea Girt adopted Chapter IX entitled "Beaches, Boardwalk and Dune" of the Borough Code setting forth rules and regulations applicable thereto that may be amended from time to time by Resolution of the Borough Council [Chapter IX, Section 1.2(z)]; and,

WHEREAS, Chapter IX, Section 1.2 (m) of the Borough Code permits bicycles on the Boardwalk between May 15 and September 15 between the hours of 5:00 AM and 10:00 AM only; and,

WHEREAS, the Borough Council has determined that it is in the best interests of the health and welfare of the patrons of the Borough Beach to change the hours that the public is permitted to ride bicycles on the Boardwalk to 5:00 AM to 9:00 AM and to allow Borough staff members, during their scheduled work hours, wearing appropriate safety gear, to ride bicycles on the Boardwalk at all times between May 15 and September 15.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Sea Girt that it is hereby changing the hours that the public is permitted to ride bicycles on the Boardwalk to 5:00 AM to 9:00 AM and to allow authorized Borough staff members, during their scheduled work hours, wearing appropriate safety gear, to ride bicycles on the Boardwalk at all times between May 15 and September 15, effective immediately upon adoption of this Resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this Resolution shall be supplied to the following for their information and action:

- Authorize the signing of an Agreement with Sea Girt 5K, Inc. allowing for the conduct of a foot race on August 5, 2017, waiving noise ordinance provisions and imposing parking restrictions in conjunction therewith:

WHEREAS, in previous years the Borough of Sea Girt, a Municipal Corporation of the State of New Jersey, entered into Agreements with the Sea Girt 5K, Inc., a 501(c)3 corporation of the State of New Jersey, for the sponsorship of a 5K race; and,

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Sea Girt recognize the benefit of this special event to residents of and visitors to the Borough of Sea Girt; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Recreation Commissioners of the Borough of Sea Girt, has determined that in order to provide funds, in whole or part, necessary to improve, maintain and police the playgrounds or recreation places under its control, it would be beneficial to jointly sponsor the Sea Girt 5K run on August 5, 2017; and,

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council and Sea Girt 5K, Inc. wish to enter into an Agreement to jointly conduct the Sea Girt 5K in 2017.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, as follows:

1. Sea Girt 5K, Inc. will conduct the foot race to be held on August 5, 2017, not to exceed five kilometers, as well as children's races, live music and activities;

- 2. Sea Girt 5K, Inc. will provide acceptable insurance and a release to the Borough having the Borough named as additional insured against liability and property damage for the purpose of the event. Sea Girt 5K, Inc. shall deliver to the Borough prior to the event a certificate evidencing minimum coverage in the amounts of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) per occurrence.
- 3. Sea Girt 5K, Inc. will provide evidence satisfactory to the Borough that it is a validly organized not-for-profit corporation of the State of New Jersey and will be so as of the date of the event.
- 4. The Borough of Sea Girt will permit the use of its roadways, provide police, emergency, and public works department assistance and provide insurance under the terms of its general liability insurance policy on August 5, 2017, the day of the race.
- 5. Sea Girt 5K, Inc. will pay over to the Borough of Sea Girt not less than 90% of the participation fees in the 5K Run/Walk and not less than 90% of the participation fees in the Kids' Races.
- 6. The net proceeds of the entry fees collected by Sea Girt 5K, Inc. after deduction of the expenses set forth in Section 5, above shall be retained by the Sea Girt 5K, Inc. for use and or charitable donations to be made in the sole discretion of Sea Girt 5K, Inc.
- 7. The Sea Girt Noise Ordinance is hereby waived between the hours of 7:30 AM to 8:00 AM, inclusive, on August 5, 2017.
- 8. The Sea Girt Police Department shall create a 'No Parking' Zone at the Plaza and along Washington Blvd. to Sixth Avenue from Midnight through 12:00 Noon, inclusive, on August 5, 2017.

Captain Macko advised that he will address with the staff.

6. OLD BUSINESS

1. Ordinance No. 10-2017 – public hearing/possible adoption

The Mayor to read the said Ordinance by Title and advice of its publication in *The Asbury Park Press* on June 1, 2017:

ORDINANCE NO. 10-2017

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR VARIOUS IMPROVEMENTS TO THE BEACH PAVILION AND BOARDWALK AND PROVIDING FOR THE COST THEROF FROM THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND OF THE BOROUGH OF SEA GIRT BEACH UTILITY, COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, NEW JERSEY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Sea Girt, County of Monmouth, as follows:

Section 1. The Borough Council of the Borough of Sea Girt wishes to undertake various general improvements in the Beach Utility of the Borough of Sea Girt as listed below:

DESCRIPTION OF IMPROVEMENT	ESTIMATED COST
Rehabilitation of Pavilion concession area floor	\$ 6,200
Boardwalk railing restoration	15,000

Section 2. The improvements as stated above are general improvements that the Borough may lawfully undertake and the amount appropriated therefor is \$21,200.

Section 3. No debt is to be issued for said improvement and the cost of said improvement is to be financed from the funds presently accumulated in the Capital Improvement Fund of the Borough of Sea Girt Beach Utility.

Section 4. Repeal, Severability.

- -a. All-ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are repealed, but only to the extent of such inconsistency.
- b. If any section, paragraph, subparagraph, clause or provision of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subparagraph, clause or provision so adjudged and the remainder of this ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

Section 5. Effective Date

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its final passage and publication as required by law.

UPON MOTION of Councilperson Morris, seconded by Councilperson Meixsell, carried, that the meeting be opened to the public for comments on the said Ordinance only.

Mr. Kregg, Boston Blvd., asked if we have a warranty and Mrs. Carafa responded that there is a one year warranty. There being no further comments and **UPON MOTION** of Councilperson Mulroy, seconded by Council President Fetzer, carried, the public hearing was closed.

UPON MOTION of Councilperson Mulroy, seconded by Councilperson Foley, carried, that the said Ordinance No. 10-2017 be adopted on final reading, directing the Clerk to post and publish as required by law.

7. **NEW BUSINESS**

A. Ordinance 11-2017 – Introduction: The Mayor to read the said Ordinance by Title:

ORDINANCE NO. 11-2017

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AND SUPPLEMENT CHAPTER X, PARKS AND RECREATION, ARTICLE 10-1, MUNICIPAL TENNIS COURTS AND ARTICLE 10-2, PADDLE TENNIS COURTS, TO SET RULES FOR USE OF MUNICIPAL TENNIS AND PADDLE TENNIS COURTS IN THE BOROUGH OF SEA GIRT, MONMOUTH COUNTY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Sea Girt as follows:

10-1 MUNICIPAL TENNIS COURTS.

10-1.1 Use by Residents Only.

The tennis courts on Bell Place and Crescent Park are for the use of the residents of the Borough upon registration and the payment of the appropriate fee. Residents may register for an annual, weekly or daily permit; the *members* of the Recreation *Commission*, the officers of the Police Department and other

authorized personnel of the Borough may demand, at any time, proof of payment of the permit fee as a condition precedent to the use of the aforesaid tennis courts by any person. (Ord. No. 547 § 1)

- 10.1.1.1 Resident shall be defined as any person owning, residing in or legally renting a residence in the Borough of Sea Girt.
- 10.1.1.2 *Renting* shall be defined as inhabiting a residence located in the Borough for which the property owner has registered for a landlord license and a Certificate of Occupancy for the rental has been issued by the Zoning Official of the Borough.
 - 10-1.2 Replaced in its entirety as shown below
 - 10-1.2 Permit Required; Fees.
 - a. Fees.
 - 1. Annual membership, available to residents only:
 - a. The annual family membership for parents and minor children residing in the same household valid from March 1 to February 28 of the following year: one hundred fifteen (\$115.00) dollars.
 - b. individual membership permit: sixty-five (\$65.00) dollars.
 - 2. Weekly permit (valid for a single, seven (7) day period of consecutive days only): \$20.00
 - 3. Daily permit fees: ten (\$10.00) dollars per day.
 - 4. Permit fees are non-refundable.
- b. Purchase of Permits. All permits <u>shall be purchased using the on-line access and reservation process.</u>
- c. Reservations. Reservation for court time <u>shall be obtained using the on-line reservation system.</u> Holders of an annual permit or purchaser of a weekly or daily permit may make a reservation to play subject to the following rules:
 - 1. Reservations are valid for a maximum of two (2) consecutive hours of play
 - 2. When the application for reservation is made the applicant must furnish the name and address of all players and pay the appropriate fees for all persons not registered for a permit.
 - 3. Prioritization of access:
- 1. Permit holders with a valid reservation shall have priority over permit holders without a reservation;
- 2. Permit holders without a valid reservation shall have priority over those without a valid permit.

3. Groups must relinquish the court to those with priority over them. If groups have equal priority, the courts are available on a first-come, first served basis. Two (2) hour maximum play time when others are waiting to play.

10-1.3 Rules and Regulations.

The Recreation <u>Commission</u> of the Borough is authorized to prepare, in writing, reasonable rules and regulations for the use and maintenance of the tennis courts. Rules and regulations shall be available upon request by any resident of Sea Girt and, further, pertinent excerpts of such rules and regulations shall be posted conspicuously at the tennis courts on Bell Place and Crescent Park. (Ord. No. 547 § 3)

a. Other:

- 1. Proper tennis footwear is required on the courts at all times.
- 2. No pets allowed on the courts at any time.
- 3. <u>No skateboarding, roller blading, bicycle riding or other activities allowed on the courts at</u> any time.

10-1.4 Violations and penalties.

Every person, firm, association, organization or corporation violating any provisions of this article or any regulations adopted pursuant thereto shall, upon conviction, be liable to the penalty stated in Chapter 1, General Provisions, Article 1-5 et seq., General Penalty.

10-2 PLATFORM TENNIS COURTS.

10-2.1 Hours of Operation.

The platform tennis court are solely for the use of the residents of the Borough. Non-resident guests are permitted when accompanied by a resident who is a member upon purchase of a daily permit. The platform tennis court may be used between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m. daily, except when not in use the court shall be kept locked at all times. (Ord. No. 946 § 1)

10-2.2 Permit Required; Fees.

- a. Fees.
- 1. Annual family membership for parents and minor children residing in the same household valid from June 1 to May 31 of the following year: one hundred fifteen (\$115.00) dollars.
 - 2. Annual individual membership permit: sixty-five (\$65.00) dollars.
 - 3. Daily permit: fifteen (\$15.00) dollars.
 - 4. Permit fees are non-refundable.
- b. Purchase of Permits. Annual permits shall be purchased using the on-line access and reservation process.

- c. Reservations. Reservation for court time <u>shall be obtained using the on-line reservation system</u>. Holders of an annual permit or purchaser of a daily permit may make a reservation to play subject to the following rules:
 - 1. When the application for reservation is made the applicant must furnish the name and address of all players and pay the appropriate fees for all persons not holding an annual permit.
 - 2. Persons obtaining a reservation will be given a key to the court fifteen (15) minutes prior to the reserved time. At the conclusion of the reserved time the holder of the reservation shall leave the court and <u>return the key to the lockbox affixed to the exterior of Police Headquarters</u>. In no event may the key be left with succeeding players. If applicable, on leaving the court, lights and heat shall be turned off. Players without a reservation may be bumped by persons with the reservation. (Ord. No. 946 § 2; Ord. No. 2007-20 § 2; New)

d. Violations and penalties.

Every person, firm, association, organization or corporation violating any provisions of this article or any regulations adopted pursuant thereto shall, upon conviction, be liable to the penalty stated in Chapter 1, General Provisions, Article 1-5 et seq., General Penalty.

Councilperson Morris asked if the paddle tennis courts are self-sustaining; Councilperson Foley noted the annual maintenance costs are fairly low but we do have a large expense for replacing the heater; Councilperson Mulroy asked if only people registered with a pass are able to make a reservation; guests are required to pay a fee; online-reservations will be available for tennis players also; Mayor Farrell noted it is difficult to police the courts; Councilperson Morris noted the paddle courts are separate from the tennis courts as far as fees; transfers between recreation trust accounts are approved by Council; Council President Fetzer seems to believe that there is separate accounting for both paddle and tennis courts to know if self-liquidating.

- 2. ACCEPTANCE. Sea Girt accepts the indicated vehicle in the condition delivered. Sea Girt has inspected the Vehicle prior to acceptance. Parkway warrants and represents that it knows of no defects relative to the vehicle.
- 3. DISCLAIMER OF WARRANTIES AND CLAIMS; LIMITATION OF REMEDIES. PARKWAY, NOT BEING THE MANUFACTURER OF THE VEHICLE MAKES NO EXPRESS OR IMPLIED WARRANTY OF ANY KIND WHATSOEVER WITH RESPECT TO THE VEHICLE, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, THE MERCHANTABILITY OF THE VEHICLE OR ITS FITNESS FOR ANY PARTICULAR PURPOSE; THE DESIGN OR CONDITION OF THE VEHICLE; THE QUALITY OR CAPACITY OF THE VEHICLE; THE WORKMANSHIP IN THE VEHICLE; COMPLIANCE OFHTE VEHICLE WITH THE REQUIREMENT OF ANY LAW, RULE, SPECIFICATION OR CONTRACT OR LATENT DEFECTS. SEA GIRT LICENSES THE VEHICLE "AS IS." PARKWAY WARRANTS AND REPRESENTS THAT IT KOWS OF NO DEFECTS RELATIVE TO THE VEHICLE.

Sea Girt specifically acknowledges that the vehicle is licensed to Sea Girt solely for commercial or business purposes and not for personal, family, household, or agricultural purposes.

- 4. ASSIGNMENT BY SEA GIRT PROHIBITED. Without Parkway's prior written consent, Sea Girt shall not assign this license or sublicense the vehicle or any interest therein, or pledge or transfer this license, or otherwise dispose of the vehicle covered hereby.
- 5. LICENSE PAYMENTS. There shall be no fee for the License or for the use of this Vehicle by the Borough of Sea Girt.
- 6. USE. Sea Girt shall use the Vehicle in a careful manner, shall make all necessary repairs at Sea Girt's expense, and shall comply with all laws relating to its possession, use or maintenance, and shall not made any alterations, additions or improvements to the Vehicle without Parkway's prior written consent.
- 7. Sea Girt shall insure the vehicle with a company authorized to issue insurance within the State of New Jersey for the replacement cost of said vehicle.
- 8. INSURANCE; LIENS; TAXES. Sea Girt shall bear the entire risk of loss, theft, damage or destruction of the Vehicle from any cause whatsoever except for any defects known by Parkway. Sea Girt shall provide and maintain insurance against such loss, theft, damage or destruction of the Vehicle in an amount equal to the Actual Cash Value (ACV) of the Vehicle. Sea Girt shall also provide and maintain comprehensive general all-risk liability insurance coverage, insuring Parkway and Sea Girt, against any and all loss or liability for damages either to person or property or otherwise, which might result from or happen in connection with the condition, use or operation of the Vehicle. Each policy shall expressly provide that said insurance as to Parkway and its assigns shall not be invalidated by any act, omission or neglect of Sea

Girt and cannot be canceled without 30 days written notice to Parkway. As to each policy, Sea Girt shall furnish to Parkway a certificate of insurance from the insurer, which certificate shall evidence the insurance coverage required by this Paragraph and shall designate Parkway as additional insured.

Sea Girt shall keep the Vehicle free and clear of all levies, liens and encumbrances. Sea Girt shall pay all charges, tolls and taxes (local, state and federal) which may now or hereafter be imposed upon the leasing, purchase, possession or use of the Vehicle.

If Sea Girt fails to procure or maintain said insurance or to pay said charges or taxes, Parkway shall have the right, but shall not be obligated, to affect such insurance, or pay such charges or taxes. In that event, Parkway shall notify Sea Girt of such payment and Sea Girt shall repay to Parkway the cost thereof within 15 days after such notice is mailed to Sea Girt.

9. INDEMNITY. Sea Girt shall indemnify Parkway, its agents, employees, successors and assigns against any claims, actions, damages or liabilities, including all attorney fees, arising out of the use and operation of the Vehicle. Such indemnification shall survive the expiration, cancellation or termination of this license. Se Girt waives any immunity of Sea Girt may have under any laws as to sovereign immunity with regard to indemnification of Parkway.

Parkway agrees to defend and indemnify and hold harmless Sea Girt, its affiliates, officers, agents, servants and employees from and against any and all claims and liabilities (including reasonable attorney's fees and expenses, including expert fees, incurred in the defense thereof) relating to personal injury or property damage or any other claim arising out of the acts or omissions, including negligence or malpractice, of Parkway, or of any of its officers, directors, employees, agents, servants or independent contractors in connections with their responsibilities under this Agreement as it relates to the motor vehicle itself. Parkway's liability under this agreement shall continue after the termination of this agreement with respect to any liability, loss, expense or damage resulting from acts occurring prior to termination.

- 10. ASSIGNMENT BY PARKWAY. Assignment by Parkway is not permitted.
- 11. DEFAULT. Sea Girt shall be in default of this License if:
 - a. The Vehicle or any part thereof shall be subject to any lien, levy, seizure, assignment, transfer, bulk transfer, encumbrance, application, attachment, execution, sub-License, or sale without prior written consent of Parkway, or if Sea Girt shall abandon the Vehicle or permit any other entity or person to use the Vehicle without the prior written consent of Parkway.
- 12. REMEDIES. If Sea Girt is in default, Parkway, with notice to Sea Girt, shall have the right to exercise any one or more of the following remedies, concurrently or separately and without any election of remedies being deemed to have been made:
 - a. Parkway may require Sea Girt, at its expense, to return the Vehicle in good repair, ordinary wear and tear resulting from proper use thereof alone excepted, by delivering it to such place or carrier as Parkway may specify;
 - b. Parkway may cancel or terminate this License.

No right or remedy conferred upon or reserved to Parkway is exclusive of any other right or remedy herein, or by law or by equity provided or permitted, but each shall be cumulative of every other right or remedy given herein or ow or hereafter existing by law or equity or by statue or otherwise, and may be enforced concurrently therewith or from time to time. No single or partial exercise by Parkway of any right or remedy hereunder shall preclude any other or further exercise of any other right or remedy.

13. EXPENSE OF ENFORCEMENT. In the event of any legal action with respect to this License, the prevailing party in any such action shall be entitled to reasonable attorney fees, including attorney fees incurred at the trial level, including actin in bankruptcy court, on appeal or review, or incurred without action, suits or proceedings, together with all costs and expenses incurred in pursuit thereof.

- 14. SEVERABILITY. This Agreement is intended to constitute a valid and enforcement legal instrument. In the event any provision hereof is declared invalid, such provisions will be deemed severable from the remaining provisions of this license, all of which will remain in full force and effect.
- 15. ENTIRE AGREEMENT; WAIVER. This instrument and the Schedules executed by Parkway and Sea Girt constitute the entire agreement between Parkway and Sea Girt with respect to the Vehicle and the subject matter of this License. No provision of this License shall be modified unless in writing signed by an authorized representative of Parkway. Waiver by either party of any provision hereof in one instance shall not constitute a waiver of any other instance.
- 16. CHOICE OF LAW; JURISDICTION. Both parties agree to jurisdiction in the State of New Jersey in any action, suit or proceeding arising out of this Lease. In the event of legal action to enforce this License, both parties agree that venue may be laid in Monmouth County.
- 17. Whenever the consent of any party is required, such consent shall not be unreasonably withheld nor delayed.
- 18. NOTICES. All notices, requests, demands and other communications hereunder shall be written, and shall be deemed to have been duly given if delivered or mailed, by certified mail, return receipts requested, to the parties hereto at the addresses stated on the first page of this contract.
