Section 3. Article 7-26 TURN PROHIBITIONS is hereby supplemented and amended as follows:

WHEREAS, the Concessionaire satisfactorily operated the facility during the term of the 2016 lease and the Borough has the right to renew for year 2017 based upon the bid specifications and Lease Agreement at the annual rent in the amount of \$82,140.00 for the 2017 season; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Sea Girt that the Concessionaire be authorized to operate the Boardwalk Concession at the Sea Girt Beach for the 2017 season at the annual rent of \$82,140.00.
