- A. **The Terrace Rehabilitation Project** again, the project was delayed by rain, but work has begun between 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenues; if all goes well, the project should be completed by the end of the month, about two weeks behind schedule.
- B. **Beach News** Season badges are still available for purchase; last Friday, there were many children on the beach for class pictures. Several children were at the water line when they were pulled into the water and were experiencing distress; a parent ran into the water to help and was also pulled out into the rough surf. A surfer who was nearby paddled over and was able to pull the two distressed children onto his board and also helped the parent who was in distress. Everyone was taken to the hospital for observation and thankfully are ok. We commend our the surfer, EMS, police, fire and lifeguards for their timely response and assistance.

- D. **Zoning Reminder** Pursuant to Chapter XI, Rental Property, Section 11-1 et seq. of the Borough Code, *all* property owners must obtain a Permit before a property can be rented and also requires that a Rental Certificate of Occupancy be issued before leasing all or any part of a residential property and for any change of tenancy thereafter. Memorial Day Parade and Ceremony I wanted to share this with you this is an excerpt of an e-mail that I received on May 30 from a resident who wishes to remain anonymous: "With the cancellation of the ceremony due to the weather.....now the interesting part. When I thought I would be alone, in the rain, at a cancelled event, I was more than pleasantly surprised by the small gathering of residents already there. I counted more than two dozen people, many with their pets, some dressed in patriotic colors, doing the same thing I was doing.....paying well deserved homage and respect to those to whom rain no longer mattered. People were not in any rush to seek shelter, they talked to each other respectfully about those who paid the ultimate sacrifice, and visited each memorial along the line.

I noted two police officers in rain gear, three firefighters along with the Chief, all standing in the rain quietly rendering honors. To top off this glorious, wet day, Father Griffin from St. Uriel's, stopped by and offered an appropriate prayer and comments to the unplanned gathered group, many with military baseball caps, some with the wars in which they served on the front. If no one else, I know these military personnel stood a little taller today.

I try to attend the Memorial Day Ceremony each year; this is one I will never forget. It may have been raining, but there was a small circle of sunshine around those two dozen people."
