- A. **The Crescent Park Rehabilitation Project** –Council Sub-Committees, Public Buildings, Grounds and Landscaping and Public Works, have met to discuss the matter; reports/recommendations will be issued shortly.
- B. Outfall and Infrastructure Improvement Project
 - Neptune Outfall completed as of May 27; final clean-up of area completed;
 - **Baltimore Outfall** we have not yet received a response to the Borough's inquiry regarding a design modification to address the complaints about the aesthetics;
