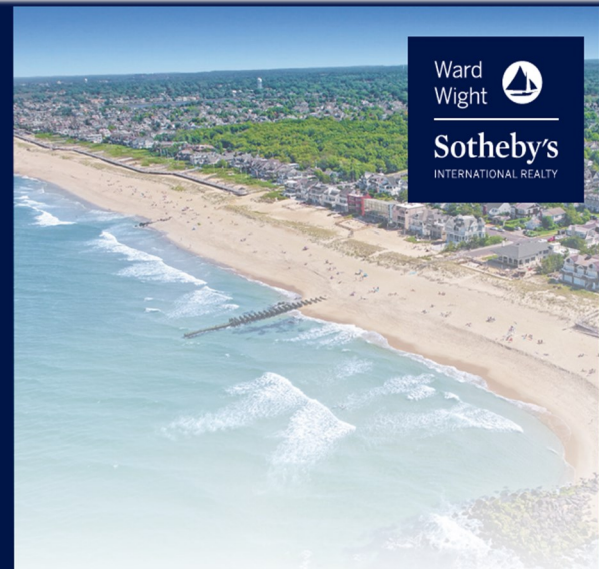

Please note : That for the **safety** of our employees, all trash and recycling containers must be 34 gallons or less and weigh 40 pounds or less; recycling containers must also have holes in the bottom to drain off liquids and rainwater.
Cans larger than 34 gallon capacity and/or overweight cans will not be picked up.
Oversized or "robo-type" cans cannot be used for either household trash or recycling collection.

Basic Guidelines for Garbage & Recycling Pick-Up:

- **Plastic bags or liners cannot be used in your recycling can.**
- Garbage and Recycling must be out by **7:00am** for pickup.
- **Cans must be easily accessible and visible from your driveway**, free from obstructions including vehicles.
- If you do not want our staff to enter your driveway with a scooter, the cans must be placed curbside.
- All household garbage must be bagged and tied. No loose trash will be picked up. **Pizza boxes** are household trash.
- Single-stream Recycling includes bottles, cans, newspaper, junk mail and cardboard. Cardboard that does not fit in can must be broken down, that is, flattened and tied. **The following items are not recyclable** and must be disposed of with household trash: pizza boxes, foil, pie tins, trays, cookware, dishware, light bulbs, ceramics, plants and plant pots and window glass, shredded paper.
- The staff is not allowed to enter garages, sheds, decks or homes to collect trash or recycling.
- In the event of snow, trash and recycling may be placed at the curb **after snow plowing has been completed.** Normal collection will resume only if there is a pathway free of snow and ice.

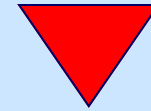

Disposable household items should be placed at the curb after 6:00pm the preceding Saturday. Doors must be removed from washers, dryers, refrigerators, etc. Pursuant to County regulations, the following items are excluded from bulk pick-up: automobile parts, tires, building materials, tree stumps, chemicals, paint cans, concrete blocks, bricks, etc.

Winter Pick-Up: Monday, February 26 weather permitting

March to December: Every Monday, beginning March 18, 2024. No weekly garden trash pickup when bulk pick-up is scheduled. If Monday is a holiday, pick up will be completed **ON THURSDAY**. Garden trash is to be placed at the curb (the area between the sidewalk and curb) **after 6:00pm** the preceding Sunday in **OPEN CONTAINERS or PAPER BAGS weighing no more than 40 lbs. and no larger than 34 gallons.; 4 can limit per pick up (NO PLASTIC BAGS).** Branches must be tied in bundles no larger than 4 feet long by 2 feet in diameter or they will not be picked up. Grass clippings are banned from the County landfill, so please "cut it and leave it" on your lawn. **There are no facilities for garden trash/debris in the Borough yard.**

Christmas Trees

Should be left curbside and will be picked up through January 31, 2024

Leaves - Curbside Pick-Up

April 15 to May 17 and October 15 to December 20:

Leaves are to be raked to the gutter. Piles of leaves may not be placed within 15 feet of a storm drain.

For safety reasons, piles of leaves may not be placed on Rt. 71 or less than 15 ft. from the intersection of any road and Rt. 71. Do not mix grass, flowers or branches in the leaves, or they will not be picked up.

Office Of Emergency Management

The Borough of Sea Girt Office of Emergency Management (OEM) identifies natural or man-made hazards and vulnerabilities and programs to eliminate or reduce the effects of such threats. It coordinates the resources of local, state, and federal agencies in response to any disaster or emergency event in an effort to lessen the effects on the residents of the Borough and to speed the recovery process.

Stay tuned to **NOAA weather radio** for the latest severe weather information.

Create a **family emergency plan** should unexpected severe weather or loss of essential services come about.

- Family emergency plan should include basic safety measures, emergency phone numbers and plans to stay with friends or relatives should an evacuation be ordered.
- Have a single designated family contact should evacuation and family separation take place.
- Have a plan with an alternative location to live in the event of a disaster, such as prolonged power outage or an uninhabitable home.
- Remember to bring prescription medications and eyeglasses if evacuated.
- Household members should know how to turn off water, electric, and gas to their home.
- Three day supply of food and water should be kept.
- Three gallons of water per person, per day is recommended.
- Store food such as canned food which require little or no water, and have longer expiration dates.
- Keep on hand a first aid kit, fire extinguisher, flashlight, fresh batteries, matches, and work gloves.
- Learn basic safety measures such as CPR and first aid.
- Have a plan for your pets. For additional information on pet safety please refer to the official FEMA website.





- Individual Membership Permit: \$65.00

2. Reserve a tennis court for play online by opening an account at: <https://seagirtcourtreservations.playbypoint.com/>

Reservations for playing time may be made by residents only with a valid tennis permit up to 24 hours in advance by accessing the above online reservation system. A valid reservation will have priority for court usage and may ask others without a reservation to vacate the court by showing their online reservation confirmation. You will have the option to receive an email confirmation of your reservation sent to you as proof of your reservation. Time limit of 2 hours for reservations and play if others are waiting to use court. As a courtesy to all permit holders, all reservations that go unused must be cancelled via the reservation system prior to the planned start time.
